MRRRA Director Nomination Eligibility

The Association Officers shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer. The Board of Directors shall be composed of the officers, and four additional members. Non-voting positions will be filled by representatives of governmental agencies as approved by the Board of Directors. No member of the Board of Directors shall represent commercial interest.

To be eligible, Director candidates shall have been appointed as a representative to MRRRA by their member organization prior to the distribution of ballots. Representatives of member organizations that are in competition with MRRRA are not eligible candidates and may not be seated as Directors.

No member organization may offer more than one Director candidate in any election year. Write-in candidates who have not been nominated may be elected to the Board so long as they are eligible candidates.
