Siding needs to be clean and free of mud, rocks and dirt.

If the material is dusty, that's ok.

Keep nails and Metal brackets

Out of the pile.

Other items to bring:

Plastic lattice and cut-offs are fine.

## What can be recycled

### Do's

We are looking for vinyl siding that has been removed from your house, barn, garage, or shed.

Bring us your plastic lattice work that was around your deck.

PVC fencing posts and rails can be recycled.

New cut offs from brand new installation are ok.

Any color is fine and can be mixed .

### Don'ts

We can not take sewer pipe or old water pipes.



Can't take muddy dirty pieces.

A few cobwebs or dust is ok but the mud and dirt hurt our processing equipment.

We can't take nails or metal straps.

If you want to bring vinyl window frames make sure all of the glass and insulation is removed.

## Vinyl Siding and PVC Recycling

The siding to be recycled needs to be clean and free of mud, rocks and dirt.

If the material is dusty, that's ok.

Keep out the nails and metal brackets

Other items to bring:

Plastic lattice and cut-offs are fine.

Shutters are good to bring also. Broken ones are fine.



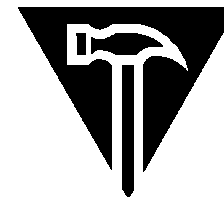
