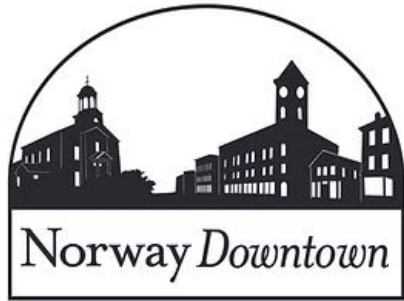

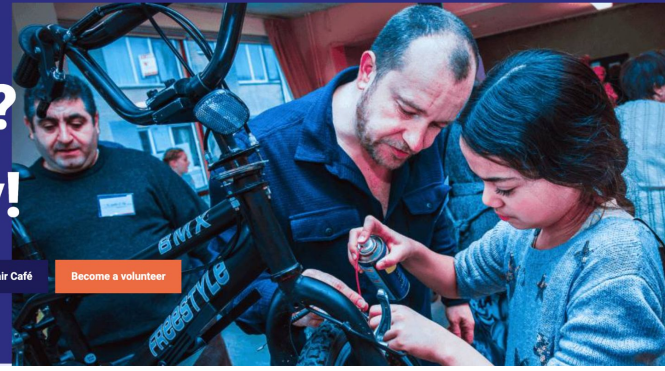

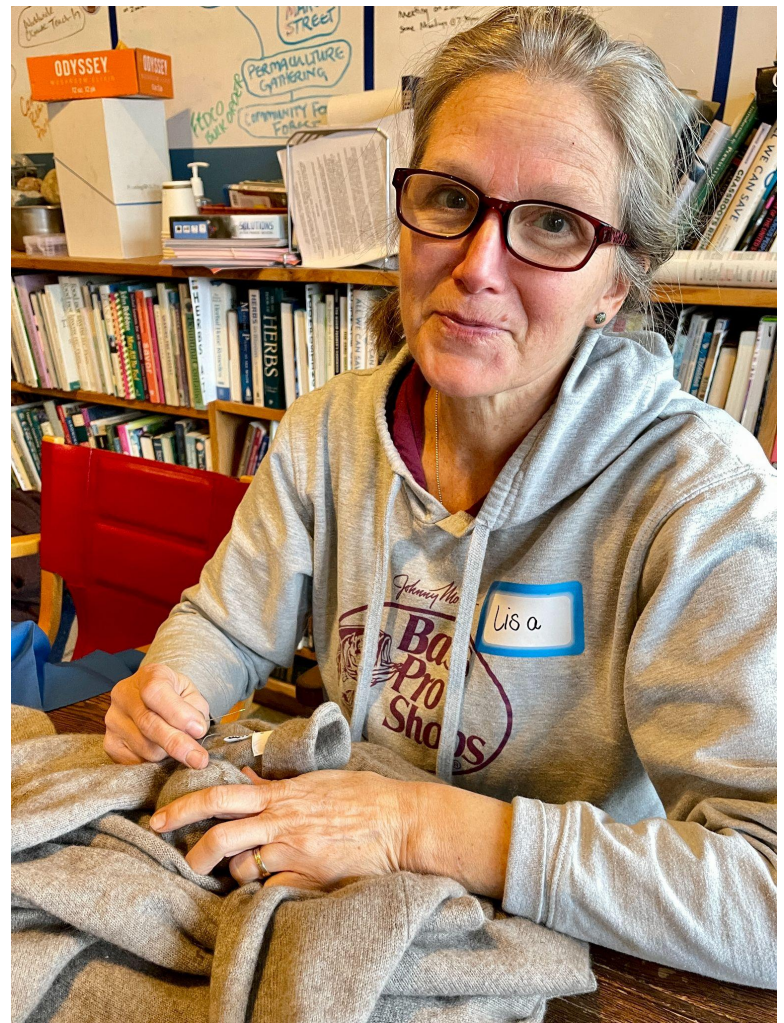

Spring 2026 Repair Cafes



April 3 - May 1 - June 5
5-7pm at CEBE

April - Repair cafe will focus on **garden tool care** such as handle repair, sanding, refinishing, and rehangng (replacing handles).

May - We will team up with the Bike Coalition of Maine for a cafe centered on **bike repair** and the kickoff of CEBE's 2026 Bike Share!

June - We'll be joined by Horticulturist Corey Kotfila, from McLaughlin Gardens who will share tips for **sharpening garden tools**.

All cafes will also provide materials and guidance for sewing (patching, darning, buttons), ceramics repair, simple jewelry fixes (non-soldering), leather shoe maintenance, knife sharpening, lamp cords, and other minor repairs.
